Community Care Plan (CCP), formerly known as South Florida Community Care Network, would like to invite you to participate in our Pay for Performance Capitation Program (P4P) which is the way CCP participates in the MMA Physician Incentive Program (MPIP). This Program has been designed for in-network providers who are dedicated to healthy outcomes for their assigned patients, and interested in increasing their National Committee on Quality (NCQA) HEDIS Score Performance. It is an interactive program that aligns your practice performance with the program standards while providing the physician the opportunity to be paid an equivalent to the appropriate Medicare Rate, as established by the Agency for Health Care Administration (Agency), including coverage of Primary Care Services, as specified by CCP and approved by the Agency, beginning with capitation payments made for October 2016.

What is the Pay for Performance Capitation Program?

It is a program developed by CCP to provide physicians with tools to support the delivery of high quality care for patients. The program assesses physician performance in the delivery of evidenced-based care and usage of recommended clinical guideline recommendation. We are aware that impacting multiple HEDIS metrics can seem like a daunting task. That is why we developed a unique program that incorporates cost free customized data and reports specific to your practice with on-going training and technical assistance, if needed. The data provided serves as the basis for a targeted approach to close the gaps on key quality clinical measures. This is a capitation based program that rewards your practice performance with additional reimbursement by meeting specified criteria.

What are the Benefits of participating in the program?

CCP collaborates with the providers who participate in the program using sophisticated data algorithms and analytics to produce user-friendly and accurate reports to assist in enhancing your practice's HEDIS performance scores. At CCP, we believe that the provider is essential to improving the quality of care for patients. The participation in the capitation program enables physicians to be paid an equivalent to the appropriate Medicare Rate, as established by the Agency.. CCP will make this information accessible to providers. Additionally, achieving qualitative performance metrics may yield additional reimbursement through CCP's own physician incentive program. Finally, CCP will assist those providers interested in being PCMH (Patient Centered Medical Home) in the accreditation process.

Who qualifies to participate?

Physicians must meet all of the following criteria:

- Have participated in-network for six consecutive months with Community Care Plan (CCP)
- Board Certified in Pediatrics by the American Board of Pediatrics or the American Osteopathic Board of Pediatrics.
