Are you or your child a member between the ages of 5 and 19? CCP is working with Tutor.com. They provide help 24 hours a day, seven days a week at no cost to you! That means when your student needs help with their homework or writing a paper, a teacher is there to help in just a few clicks. Tutor.com works with students of all grades from kindergarten to 12th . They offer help with more than 100 subjects, like English, Science, Math, History and more. They also help older students prepare for college entrance tests, like the SAT or ACT. As long as your child is an eligible member between the ages of 5 and 19, this benefit is ready now. Financial Literacy

Financial literacy means having the skills to handle your money. This means things like how to make a budget. Or how to save for things like college, your first home, or retirement. When it comes to money, education is key! That is why CCP is working with Consolidated Credit and KOFE (sounds like coffee). KOFE stands for Knowledge of Financial Education. This is a free service for all CCP members over the age of 21.
