There are new expanded benefits that we want to make sure that you know about. In this newsletter, there are a few expanded benefits for pregnant moms and their new babies that we are excited to tell you about.



Doula Care

Doulas are trusted, non-medical support persons. Doulas work with you and your doctor or midwife to help you before birth, during birth, and after the baby is born. CCP offers doula support during your pregnancy. You do not need an OK from CCP to get this benefit.

Newborn Circumcision

If you are a mom-to-be or new mom of a baby boy, this news is for you. If you want to have your newborn son circumcised, that is a benefit that CCP gives you. You do not need a plan OK to do this. It does have to be done before your baby turns 12 weeks old, so make sure your doctor knows early that you would like this done.









Breast Pumps

Experts agree. Breast feeding is the best nutrition for your baby. It is also cheaper and more convenient than formula. At CCP, we know there are times when you may need to pump your milk to feed your baby. If it is medically necessary, CCP does pay for electric breast pumps. Your doctor must ask for this. You DO need a plan OK first.



Home-Delivered Meals

Coming home with a new baby can be stressful. The last thing you may want to do is cook. CCP offers 10 meals delivered to your home after your hospital stay. This is offered to members one time per year.
