At Community Care Plan (CCP), it pays to stay healthy. CCP wants to help you manage your health better. That is why every two months, we have member newsletters. Did you know that Community Care Plan offers rewards to members who get their yearly well visit? We also offer rewards for other healthy habits. **CCP members can earn an Amazon gift card from \$10 to \$50.** The reward is based on the member's age and the activity completed.



Getting your yearly visit is just one way to earn a reward. Members who live with diabetes can earn extra rewards for taking steps to manage their health. **Any member who completes the following annual diabetic monitoring can earn an additional \$30 gift card:**

- Special blood test for sugar level (A1c),
- Urine test (eGFR and urine albumin creatinine ratio), and
- Dilated eye exam



Do you want to quit smoking, vaping, or using tobacco products? CCP can help. We work with the Area Health Education Center (AHEC) and Nova Southeastern University (NSU) to offer free tobacco cessation programs. You will not only reward yourself, but you will breathe and feel better!








As a bonus, if you create an account on MyChart, CCP's secure member portal, you can earn an extra reward. MyChart has a lot of great benefits. You can:

- Complete the HRA,
- Get your ID card,
- Look up doctor claims, and more.

Be sure to make your appointments. Get any needed exams and tests for any CCP member in your family. Reward yourself for taking steps to a healthier you! Finally, all new members and members with certain diagnoses are asked to complete a Health Risk Assessment (HRA). Your answers will be kept private. It helps us to better understand your health needs. We offer a reward for your completing the HRA. Your answers will help us find programs or special services for you. These are not just about health. We can help with housing, food, transportation and more.



Birth & Baby


Pregnant and new moms are very special to Community Care Plan. We want to make sure that pregnant moms get the quality care that they deserve. This will also help make sure your baby gets the best possible start in life.



We also have special healthy habit rewards for pregnant moms. Whether this is your first baby or not, prenatal care visits are vital. Most women have healthy pregnancies. Your provider will keep a close eye on your and your baby's health. During your pregnancy, your provider will order tests that can find any problems early. These visits and tests improve your chances of having a healthy baby.



On the first page, we talked about the Health Risk Assessment or HRA. All pregnant moms are asked to complete our HRA, even if you did one when you first joined our plan. This helps us know if you have any conditions or needs, such as food or housing that could put you and baby at risk. With our Birth, Baby, and Beyond program, we have nurses and social workers who can help. Completing the HRA also earns you a reward. Learn more at <u>Healthy Rewards</u>.



CCP offers a \$50 reward for our pregnant moms who get a prenatal visit during their first trimester, or 12 weeks of pregnancy. If you are new to CCP, make sure to get a visit in the first six weeks on our plan. If you need help finding a provider, our Member Services department can help. Call at 1-866-899-4828. To get this reward, you must have both a prenatal and postpartum visit. The postpartum visit is the follow-up exam that all women should have between three (3) and seven (7) weeks after the baby is born. Your provider can discover any health problems that could put you at risk. Don't skip this important visit!



Once you welcome your new baby into your family, your baby's primary care provider is your partner in making sure your baby is growing as expected. In the first 15 months of life, your baby should see the pediatrician or PCP at least seven (7) times. These visits are important to make sure your baby is growing, meeting milestones, and getting any needed shots or vaccines. It is important to know that these visits need to be well visits, not times where you take your baby for a specific symptom. Taking your baby for at least seven (7) well visits before they turn 15 months old can earn you another \$50 reward.

We know babies can be costly, so why not earn rewards while keeping yourself and baby healthy. Remember, you have to ask for some rewards, so be sure to read info using the Healthy Rewards link above. CCP is happy to be your partner in caring for you and your family!
