- For 2023 Dates of Service, NCQA is still accepting telehealth services as indicators of a member being in a measure, as well as measure compliance.
  - Be sure to add modifier GT and place of service 02.
  - For hypertension patients with telehealth visits, please have them take a BP reading and document it!
- Adolescents need their teen shots! Start early to get the whole teen series completed BEFORE they turn 13!
  - $\circ$  One (1) Tdap is given between the 10<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup> birthdays.
  - One (1) MEN is given between the 11<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup> birthday.
  - Two (2) or three (3) HPV between their 9th and 13th birthday.
- A physical can be done at the same time as a sick visit using modifier 25.

- **Provider Operations Representative:** Did you know that all participating providers have a dedicated Provider Operations Representative? For more information, please contact our Provider Operations Hotline by phone at 1(855) 819-9506or via email at <u>CCP.provider@ccpcares.org</u>.
- **Provider Lenz:** CCP is utilizing this innovative Provider Lenz tool to enhance our provider validation process. This collaboration is aimed at simplifying the verification of provider information, ensuring that provider records are accurate and up to date. Your cooperation is vital in maintaining the integrity of our provider database and we thank you for your continued support and partnership.
  - As part of this initiative, providers will receive an email prompting them to validate the records they
    oversee. The process is straightforward. No login is required. To review your information, just click
    the link in the email.
- Medicaid Eligibility: All Medicaid providers are required by the Agency of Health Care Administration (AHCA) to maintain an active, limited enrolled, or enrolled status with Medicaid to receive payment. - Well Visits: May be completed via telemedicine/telehealth, a service that uses interactive telecommunications equipment, such as, at a minimum, audio, and video equipment that permit two-way, real-time, interactive communication between the patient and practitioner. Encourage members to complete their annual visit. By doing so, members can receive up to a \$20 gift card from CCP.  RSV Vaccine – MMA & FHK Plan: As part of our efforts to offer optimal care to our members, CCP now covers the RSV vaccine for pregnant women. For the latest reimbursement details, please refer to the <u>Prescribed Drugs Immunization Fee Schedule</u>



- **PlanLink Provider Portal:** PlanLink provides real-time web access to submit prior authorization requests and appeals, and view claims, referrals, coverages, and benefits. To set up your PlanLink account, please contact <a href="PlanLink@ccpcares.org">PlanLink@ccpcares.org</a> or visit <a href="mailto:e-apply.ccpcares.org">e-apply.ccpcares.org</a>.
  - You can also Check Guest Eligibility and Check Guest Claims without logging in!
  - If your organization uses a third-party billing company, please advise them that CCP's <u>Guest Claims</u> portal provides detailed claim information and DOES NOT require login credentials! They can obtain payment information, such as: Claim status including Rejected claims (coming soon!), plus Claim denial reason, Patient total, Net payable, Check number/check date, Total check amount, Service level claim codes (new!), Service level claim details (new!), and a link to the Provider Claim Appeal Form (new!).
- Heart Community Resource Center: To help address the social determinants of health, CCP has a Community Resource Center, HEART (Health Education Access Resources Tools). Heart now has a location in the Lauderdale Lakes Marketplace (3736 W Oakland Park Blvd) and a virtual site that offers free online events and resources. They are open to non-members. Learn more at <u>OurHeart.org</u>.
- **Papa**: Community Care Plan has partnered with Papa, a service that connects eligible members to a Papa Pal for help with companionship, everyday tasks, transportation, and more at no cost to the member. Adolescents and adults over 55 years old without a well visit and pregnant or postpartum moms can sign up directly with Papa. To get started with no referral required from their physician or for additional information, members should visit <u>www.ccpcares.org/papa</u>.
- Virta Health: Virta is a no-cost program for CCP members aged 18 to 79 to safely reverse type 2 diabetes. It includes a dedicated health coach, testing supplies, physician-led team care, dietary resources, and support. Providers can refer members who qualify by visiting <u>www.virtahealth.com/apply</u>. - **Newborn Circumcisions Reimbursement:** As a reminder, this service is available within the first 12 weeks of birth during the initial hospitalization visit or at a participating facility and is limited to one per lifetime. No authorization is required for participating providers, and members should not be billed for CCP-covered services as per the Provider Agreement.

 Healthcare Common Procedure Coding System (HCPCS) Codes Requiring Prior Authorization: A list of HCPCS codes for medications requiring prior authorization is available on the Providers > Pharmacy section of our website and replaces the previous authorization requirement for infusion or injectable medications. - Pharmacy Reminder: Prescription Drug Monitoring Program (PDMP): All Medicaid prescribers of opioids schedules II-V should always check the Electronic-Florida Online Reporting of Controlled Substances Evaluation(E-Forcse) system before prescribing opioids.
