Early Intervention Services (EIS) and Targeted Case Management Services

Community Care Plan (CCP) covers Early Intervention Services and Child Health Services Targeted Case Management for enrollees receiving services through the Early Steps Program.

Effective April 1, 2020, CCP will also cover occupational, physical and speech therapy provided through the Early Steps program without authorization.

EIS services covered by CCP:

CCP covers the following services listed on the enrollee's IFSP and rendered by an Early Steps program-approved provider:

- All services listed in the Florida Medicaid Early Intervention Services Coverage Policy
- Targeted Case Management for Early Steps Providers as specified in the Florida Medicaid Child Health Services Targeted Case Management Coverage and Limitations Handbook.
- Therapy services listed in the Florida Medicaid Occupational, Physical and Speech Language Pathology coverage policies when billed by an EIS provider with the TL modifier, effective April 1, 2020.

Do EIS services require Authorization?

- Early Intervention Services (EIS) and Targeted Case Management services (TCM) do not require a Prior Authorization.
- Non-participating providers will be reimbursed at the rate they received for services rendered to the enrollee immediately prior to the enrollee transitioning for a minimum of thirty (30) days unless provider agrees to an alternate rate.
- Targeted Case Management services do not require prior authorization.

EIS services rendered in the Natural Environment.

CCP reimburses for EIS, EIS TCM and EIS Therapy services provided in the natural environment. CCP will reimburse providers at 100% of the applicable Florida Medicaid Fee Schedule for the services.

Credentialing

- TCM providers do not require credentialing.
- EIS providers do require credentialing by CCP. As a reminder, EIS providers are required to have a Florida Medicaid number and state license.

Contracting

- CCP contracts with the EIS/TCM providers via a direct contract with CCP.
- If an EIS/TCM provider is not part of the Early Steps Program, CCP will contract with the provider directly.

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Which Procedure Codes to use will submitting a claim

- Provider must use the codes specified in the applicable EIS, TCM or Therapy Florida Medicaid Fee Schedule. For EIS Therapy Services, providers must include the TL modifier on the claim in the first position.
- Therapy services that are billed without the TL modifier in the first position will not be treated as an EIS-related claim. This may result in the claims being denied or paid incorrectly.

Claims Payment

- Participating and Non-Participating providers should submit Claims through a claims Clearinghouse to:
- Availity – Payer ID 59065
- Participating and Non-Participating providers that do not have a Claims Clearinghouse, may register with Availity for Direct Data Entry (DDE) of claims on their portal, at no cost to you, and CCP will receive the claims electronically:
