Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) is a therapeutic approach designed to improve socially significant behaviors, particularly for individuals with autism and developmental disabilities. Behavior Analysis (BA) services are now included in the Statewide Medicaid Managed Care (SMMC) program. It is part of CCP's covered behavioral health services under its Medicaid (MMA) and Florida Healthy Kids plans.

- ABA is covered for children and adolescents under 21 who meet specific medical criteria, typically diagnosed with ASD.
